Dear Mr. Hachinski:

This is in reply to your request for compound authorization received on May 4, 1982.

Your product Lenco Red Alert is acceptable as a denaturant for poultry carcasses, parts thereof, or poultry products intended for disposal for purposes other than human food in official establishments operating under the Federal meat and poultry inspection program. The denaturant must be deposited in all portions of the carcass or product to the extent necessary to prevent its use for human food.

In order to determine the acceptability of the physical properties of this product for the proposed use, it is necessary that you contact the Slaughter Inspection Standards and Procedures Division, Technical Services, Meat and Poultry Inspection Program Washington, DC 20250 to arrange for practical testing of the product prior to final authorization which will be issued by that Staff. Upon issuance of that authorization the product will be included in the "List of Chemical Compounds."

Acceptance of compounds by this Department is in no way to be construed as an endorsement of the compounds or of any claims made for them.

If any change is made in the labeling information or formulation, the authorization for use in official plants becomes void immediately.
